**CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS APPROVES CONTRACT WITH REDSPEED-ILLINOIS
FOR INSTALLATION AND MANAGEMENT OF ITS
RED LIGHT CAMERA TRAFFIC SAFETY PROGRAM**

LOMBARD, IL. November 6, 2007-- RedSpeed-Illinois announced today it has reached an agreement with the City of Rolling Meadows to install, maintain and operate a red light camera safety program. This contract marks the 25th contract RedSpeed has been awarded within Illinois.

Based upon statistical information provided by the Rolling Meadows Police Department, studies are underway to determine the intersections where installation of the cameras would have the most immediate safety impact. Under consideration are a number of intersections along Rohlwing, including Industrial, Euclid and Kirchoff.

Once installed the cameras will run 24 hours a day, but only capture images of violators when the light has turned to red. The benefits are three-fold: the cameras offer continual enforcement at high collision locations, do not put officers at risk, and reduce the potential for congestion.

Chief Steven Williams said, "From our standpoint, the primary goal here is safety. There has to be a deterrent to red light running; you see it all the time now. People go through stop signs and stop lights, and it's dangerous, and if we can deter people from doing that, so be it."

Deputy Chief Dave Scanlan echoed the Chief's remarks, "Our citizens have everything to gain from these cameras. If you don't break the law you have nothing to worry about. Every time you can make people aware of their driving habits they become better drivers."
